GROWING CLOSER TOGETHER

- 1) Share about a time you bought something purely on emotion and later regretted it.
- 2) What is something you remember being marketed or advertised during your childhood?

MESSAGE REFLECTION

- 1) What was something in this Sunday's message that stood out to you, inspired you, or challenged you?
- 2) Share with the group your thoughts on neuromarketing? Does it bother you, why or why not?
- 3) Elaborate on how our western culture of consumerism can lead to coveting.
- 4) In your words, how would you distinguish, if at all, between coveting and envying? What can they lead to?
- 5) What does it look like to self-fulfill (self-realize) meaning and purpose in your life? In what types of places, people, or things do we look for meaning for our lives?
- 6) How does Christ fulfill your life? How can his strength help you become content?
- 7) Share with the group your Kerygmatic story? (How has God worked in your life, to save you, to meet your needs, to bring healing, to comfort you, to convict you, or made himself know to you, etc.?)
- 8) How can our kerygmatic stories, or kerygmatic passages of Scripture, grow contentment in us?

- 1) What jumps out at you from these verses?
- 2) What is it about God's character from Hebrews 13:5 that brings contentedness?

READ - **Colossians 3:1-3** together

- 1) What jumps out at you from this passage?
- 2) How is "setting your heart on things above" (**vs 1**) different from "setting your mind on things above" (**vs 2**)? What does it look like for you to do both?
- 3) When do earthly things become wrong or sinful for you?
- 4) How does **verse 3** show you what life is like for a follower of Christ?

- 1) How have you seen God's faithfulness and provision for you in the past? Thank Him for that.
- 2) Read **Psalm 37:3-7** this week. What is one way you can "delight yourself in the Lord"?
