2. How does forgetfulness affect your relationship with God?
3. Why do you think God commanded his people to create memorial stones in Joshua 4?
4. How can remembering God's past faithfulness strengthen you during current or future struggles?
5. What kinds of stories or moments of faith should families and churches intentionally pass on?
6. Share about a time you looked back and realized God was working in ways you didn't recognize at the time.
7. Why is the cross the ultimate reminder of God's faithfulness and love?
8. What is a practical way you can intentionally remember God's faithfulness in everyday life?

READ **Psalm 78:1-7** together.

1. What is something that jumps out at you from this passage?
2. Why do you think God wanted his works intentionally taught to future generations?
3. What do you notice about the connection between remembering and obedience?
4. What can happen when people forget God's works?
5. Why is intentional teaching necessary instead of assuming the next generation will naturally develop faith?
6. What is the purpose of remembering God's faithfulness?

READ **1 Corinthians 11:23-26** together.

7. Why do you think remembrance is central to communion?
8. What does communion remind us about the character and love of God?
9. Why do you think Jesus gave his followers a repeated practice of remembrance instead of just a one-time command?
